1. Entry fee must be paid in full. Entry fee cost may be found on website or current championship poster in club. A Canadian Curling Association competitor card fee @ \$25.00 per person per event is due and payable together with entry fee for the following events: Men, Women, Seniors and Mixed.

3. Entry fees must be received three (3) weeks prior to the event. Payment may be made by cheque mailed to the above address, or via PayPal, credit card or bank debit card at PEICurling.com.
4. Post-dated cheques will not be accepted.
5. Age Eligibility:
Junior Events: The age eligibility for competition is up to a maximum of 20 years of age as of December 31st of the year prior to the Canadian Championship.
Men, Women & Mixed Events: The age eligibility for competition is a minimum of 19 years of age as of December 31st of the year prior to the Canadian Championship.
Senior Events: The age eligibility for competition is a minimum of 50 years of age as of December 31st of the year prior to the Canadian Championship.
Master Events: The age eligibility for competition is a minimum of 60 years of age as of December 31st of the year prior to the Maritime Championship.
